



Mr. Sinn is a Principal in the Chicago office of Thornton Tomasetti. He has over 35 years of combined experience at Skidmore, Owings & Merrill and TT and has been involved in the structural design of several large complex building projects including the Guggenheim Museum Bilbao, Spain, the 415m tall Trump International Hotel and Tower in Chicago, and the 115m glulam timber roof span for the Altice Arena in Lisbon.
